PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE – Tim Cullen

It is with excitement that I write this message regarding the Weyauwega - Fremont Booster Club. Our team has been working hard improve the landscape and environment for current and future student athletes in the Weyauwega – Fremont School District.

At our annual meeting on March 8th we had one major change in our policies. The percentages of how we distribute our funds from major fund raisers was adjusted from 10% individual sports fund, 80% targeted projects and facility improvements, 10% general fund to our current policy of 40% individual sports fund, 40% targeted projects and facility improvements, and 20% to the general fund. These changes were made with the intent of giving more financial assistance to the individual sports teams that participate in raising funds throughout the year. The 10% increase in funds allocated to our general fund was approved because our operation, and individual request budget was slightly under funded.

I would like to recognize the recent positive impact of the Letterman's Club has had on the Booster Club. We have had more involvement from Student Athletes at our meetings and at our events. Thank you Rena Tomaszewski for all inspiring so many to take action and give back!

Horse and Buggy Days is planned for September 16, 2017 by the Weyauwega Chamber of Commerce and the Booster Club will be holding its annual 5K that morning, please save the date.

A special thanks to all of the Booster Club officers, coaches, parents, students, administration, and volunteers; who have worked countless hours for the benefit of our programs.
