Treasurer's Report

Ending balance as of April 11, 2018: \$24,421.06. No income or expenses. Paypal account charges us \$6/month, do we want to keep it. We will cancel it for now. Jeff motion, Tammy 2nd, passed.

Old Business

Membership/Newsletter – Julia reviewed information needed. Tim read his president's message and asked how we can better improve our athletic community – coaching, volunteering, fans, Booster Club participation, etc. Jeff suggested a youth coaches night/event, mentioning the coaches more during the season. Half court shots, field goals during games sponsored by the Booster Club – fun things to do during games. Rena's letterman's club could possibly help. Pat suggested apparel or other items for coaches. Jen suggested t-shirts that are generic and possibly says Booster Club on the back – free for Booster Club members at games. Alumni nights was a suggestion by Scott. Jeff asked if we do special things that we let him know as the Athletic Director so he can plan accordingly and help market it.

Sound System – Pat took the information from 2 months ago and talked to Sideline. The information was passed along to Mr. Martin to get his feedback. We are good to go with the Sideline systems to demo for 30 days. \$200-\$250 to ship back. Batteries in system 2 year warranty, gave us references from around the nation (2 from Texas had positive feedback yesterday), fairly weatherproof, mics are compatible with BigFoot and smaller one. Systems can break apart into separately at the same time. Live mic all the time, no touch-to-talk, we should have an announcer try it. Whole package \$6100. Motion carried to trial it for 30 days.

Brian Butch Camp Update – Jen reported the forms have gone out. So far almost 40 children are registered. There is a note on the forms about the Booster Club sponsoring \$5/child. Kids are excited!

New Business

Scholarship Award – Applications are due by this Friday, Dan will pick them up. Tammy and Nick offered to be on the committee. We would also like to get a younger person in on the planning committee to help them get more involved in the process. **Dan** will reach out to Teal or Kyle. We can decide if we want to give out 1 \$500 scholarship or 2 \$250 ones. **Tim** will locate an electronic copy of the bylaws and email Julia. We would like to include some bylaws in the bylaws for scholarship. The Award Night is May 9, **Tom** will give ours out on behalf of the Club.

Website – **Julia** will ask Dawn to update the Booster Club information on the website to show we will meet permanently from now on in the Middle School IMC.

Fitness Center Update – Mr. Bleck was present to thank the Club for our support during the renovation. He shared 3 bids are being looked at for fitness/weight room equipment, information was shared in writing. The top bidder recommended by the school is total Commercial Fitness at \$78,187. There was further discussion on the leftover monies the Booster Club has allocated towards this project – wrestling mat lifts, batting cage lift, basketball hoop improvements. Mr. Bleck said later in the spring he would have a better idea as to budget costs and contingency plans.

Golf Outing – July 28, 2018. Tammy asked if we could start working on raffle basket solicitation earlier in the year. Each sport could donate a basket as an idea. She asked that everyone start to contact their folks now. **Julia** will send out an email to the coaches asking them to work on baskets before school ends.
