

Q. Why are main entrance improvements to Weyauwega-Fremont High School and Fremont Elementary recommended?

A. Reasoning

Recommended improvements to the high school and Fremont Elementary main entrances would allow for improved student/visitor traffic patterns, visitor accountability and improved outdoor building monitoring. Currently Weyauwega-Fremont High School and Fremont Elementary have one exterior barrier found at the main entrance. Improvements to the high school and Fremont Elementary main entrance would incorporate a vestibule area where all foot traffic would have to enter the building office for building access during typical school hours. Improved pedestrian accountability screening by office personnel will enhance safety factors for both schools.
